Pasadena: The success of the Pasadena Armenian Genocide Memorial, (PAGM), is the culmination of three years of work by the PAGM Committee and a unanimous approval by the Pasadena City Council. Fifteen hundred people joined together to officially commemorate the Memorial on April 18, 2015. The PAGM Committee has announced an exciting opportunity to share in the commemoration of our ancestors and have your family become part of the Pasadena Genocide Memorial project. The Memorial was designed and constructed by renowned artisans and will stand as a destination to respect and appreciate the 1.5 million martyrs of the first genocide of the 20th Century. We cannot bring our ancestors back but we can remember them and make them proud of our spirit and accomplishments within the diaspora.

There are 16 commemorative pomegranate trees within the Memorial. Each tree represents a region of Armenia that suffered loss of life during the Genocide. All of our friends and neighbors are invited to place a family donation plaque at the base of each of the trees. In addition, a number of Memorial plaques are available to be placed along with the official commemorative plaques as a part of the Memorial to denote significant financial contributions.
